CHALLENGE

Irshad Bibi mother of 3 daughters and resident of Mouza Bait Sohani, Basti Ghat Ghari Union Council Ghazi Ghat in District Muzafargarh states,

I got married 8 years ago but my marriage could not last long. I live with my brother with 3 daughters of mine. In this village we never had proper drainage systems but we dug a whole, when it was full we emptied it and filled again. It was quite dirty work but had no other option. Last year my younger daughter fell in that whole and died. It was too sad, I can not forget those painful moments.

INITIATIVE

Friends Foundation team came to our village and helped us to construct drainage for the whole village and conducted session with men and women on hygiene as well as sanitation, use of latrine, safe drinking water and proper disposal of waste water and garbage. No whole exist in our village now, all the water goes in to drainage and flows out of village.

RESULTS

My village now looks clean and hopefully no other child of my community loses life as my daughter did last year.
